He is also the ex-Chair of the Stanthorpe Community Reference Panel and ex Director of Emu Swamp Dam Pty Ltd and Granite Belt Water Ltd. Cr Pennisi believes that his personal interest is not of sufficient significance that it will lead him making a decision on the matter that is contrary to the public interest. However given that there is a current investigation taking place, he would be leaving the room, taking no part in the debate or decision on the matter.
